Dear Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that you have been selected for temporary deputation to CGI, Jeddah as Assistant Haj Officer for Haj-2018 subject to fulfilling of requisite criteria as laid down in Office Memorandum dated 01.01.2018/12.01.2018 and submission of requisite documents. It may be noted that not meeting the requisite criteria and non submission of requisite documents will lead to cancellation of your candidature.

1. You are required to complete the following formalities well in time prior to proceeding to Jeddah on deputation:
 - I. Relieving order from the parent department.
 - II. Bring Last Pay Certificate(LPC) issued by your department/office indicating last pay drawn by you and deductions thereon,(Pay slip will not be accepted in place of Last Pay Certificate)
 - III. Bring fresh Medical Certificate indicating your physical fitness.
 - IV. Have meningitis/cerebral fever/polio vaccination/cerebrospinal meningitis/a dose of tetra vaccine (AC YW 135)/ inoculation for seasonal influence/influenza A (H1N1) and obtain certificate. This certificate is required for submission to Saudi Authorities,
 - V. 06 passport size color photographs on white back ground(with straight face without wearing a cap or turban on the head).
2. Your final selection is subject to submission of documents required by Haj Division and verification of original documents (MBBS/MD/Previous Haj experience /Diploma./PG Cert. / Last Pay Certificate etc. as applicable).
3. Your deputation to Jeddah is subject to the following conditions:
 - I. You are entitled to only eight days preparation time for outward journey. In case of reporting earlier than the eight days from the date of outward journey, no T.A./D.A. would be admissible for extra days.
 - II. No conveyance and D.A. claim will be admissible for journeys performed in India for completion of formalities related to deputation.
 - III. TA claim in respect of return journey will be settled through your parent office/department.
4. Kindly send your acceptance for this offer of temporary deputation on or before 31.05.2018, failing which this offer may be cancelled without any notice and the offer may be given to next candidate in waiting list.
5. Political Clearance is being obtained from MEA and the same will be sent to RPO concerned in due course.
6. You are advised to contact the nearest Regional Passport Office to obtain Official Passport and submit the same to Haj Division, Ministry of Minority Affairs along with six colour photographs with white background and duly filled Visa form latest by 05.06.2018. In case you face any problem in obtaining Official Passport you may contact Haj Division immediately. Flights for Saudi Arabia are scheduled from 28th June to 03rd July,2018.
7. You are advised to report this office from 25th June to 30th June 2018 for completion of requisite formalities and training before proceeding deputation to Saudi Arabia.



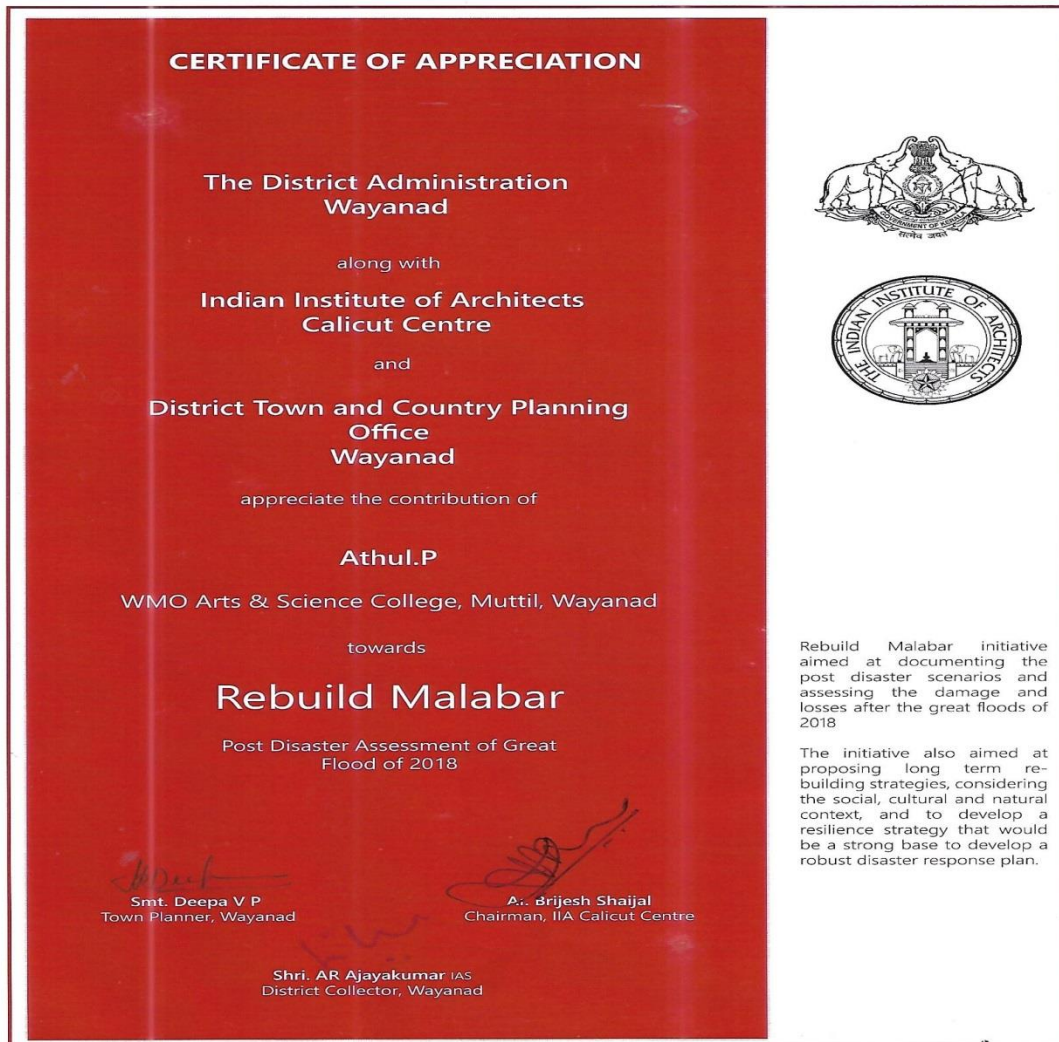

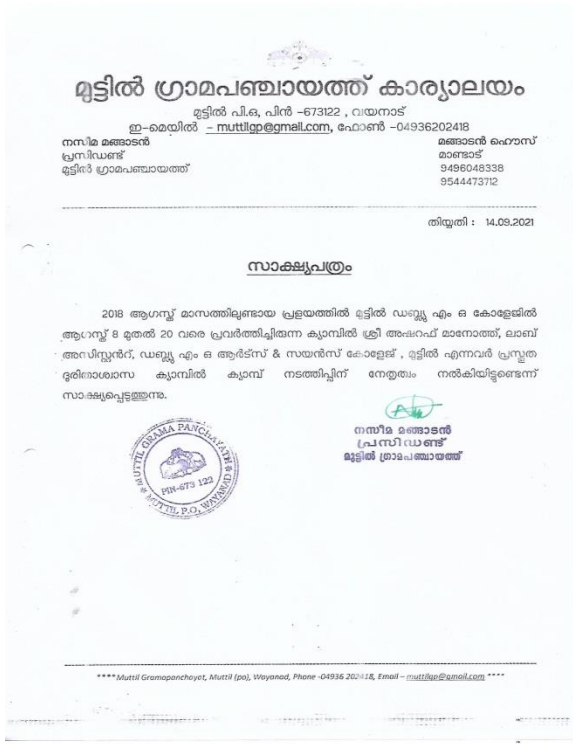
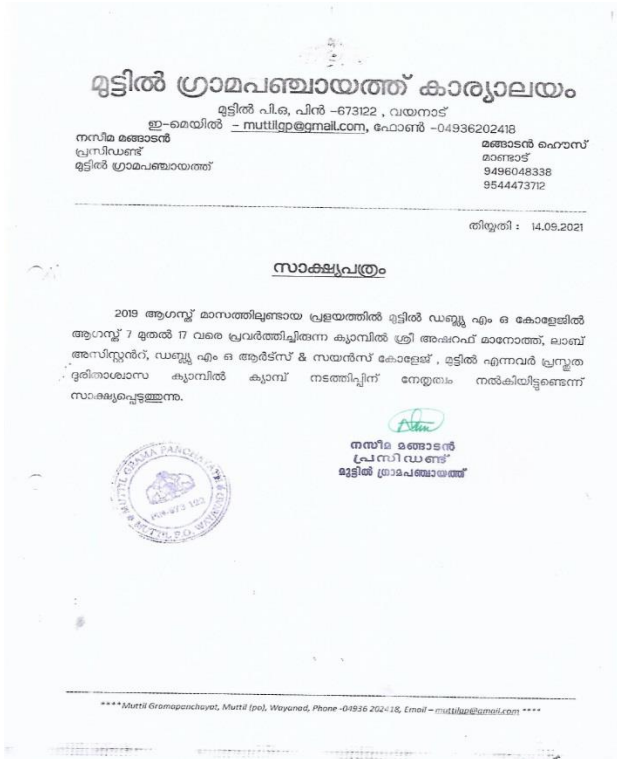
2. REBUILD MALABAR: Post Disaster Assessment of Great Flood of 2018

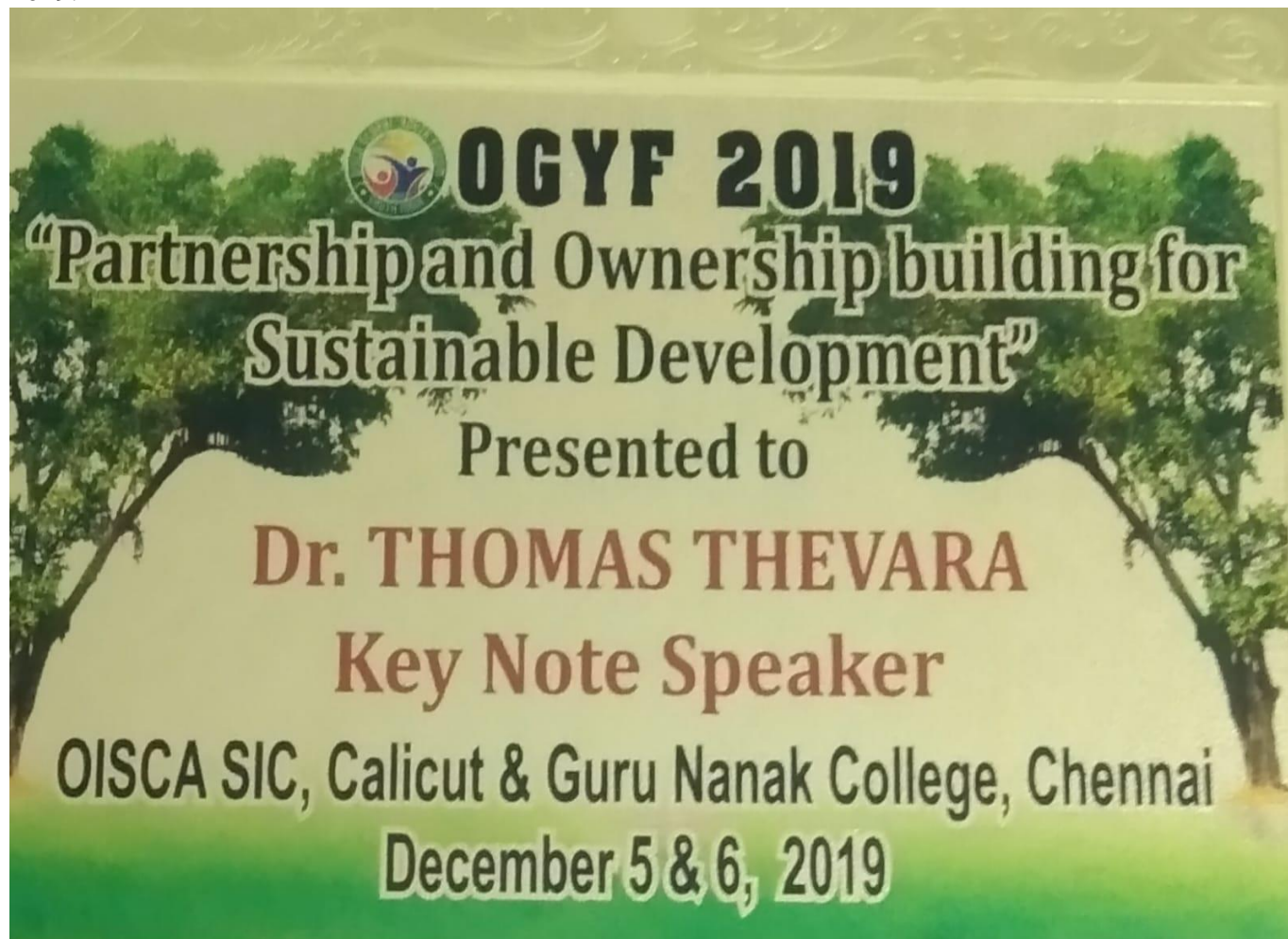



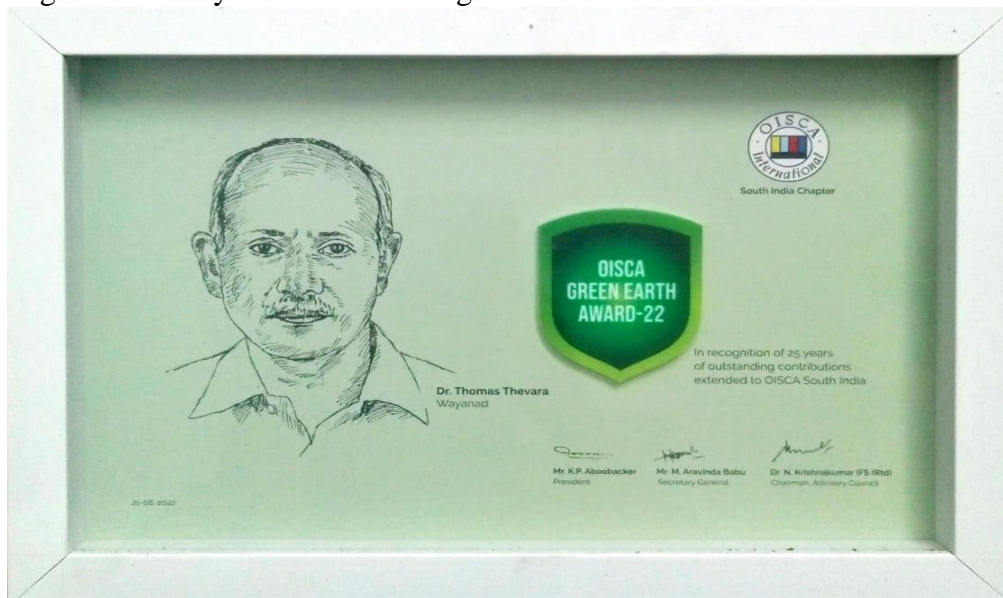
