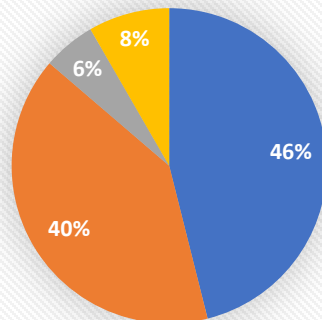

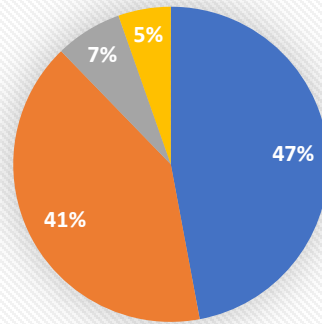

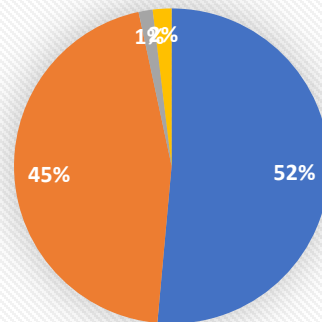


## Sufficient number of co-curricular activities were arranged during my study period



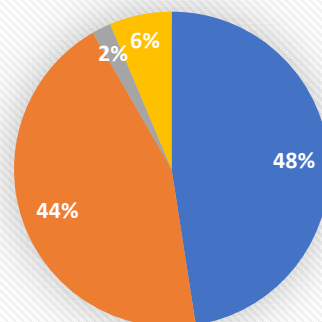

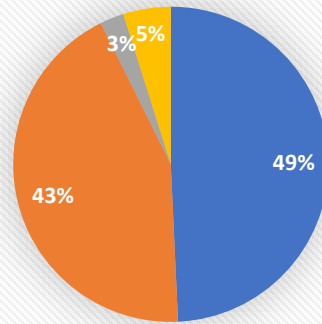

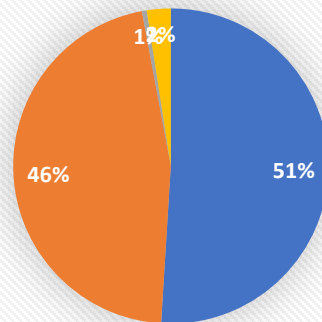


## The evaluation processes of the institution are transparent



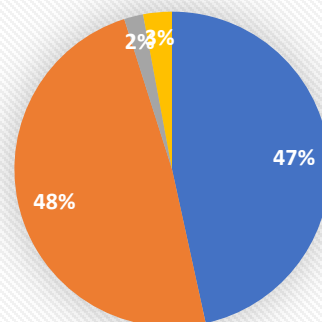
