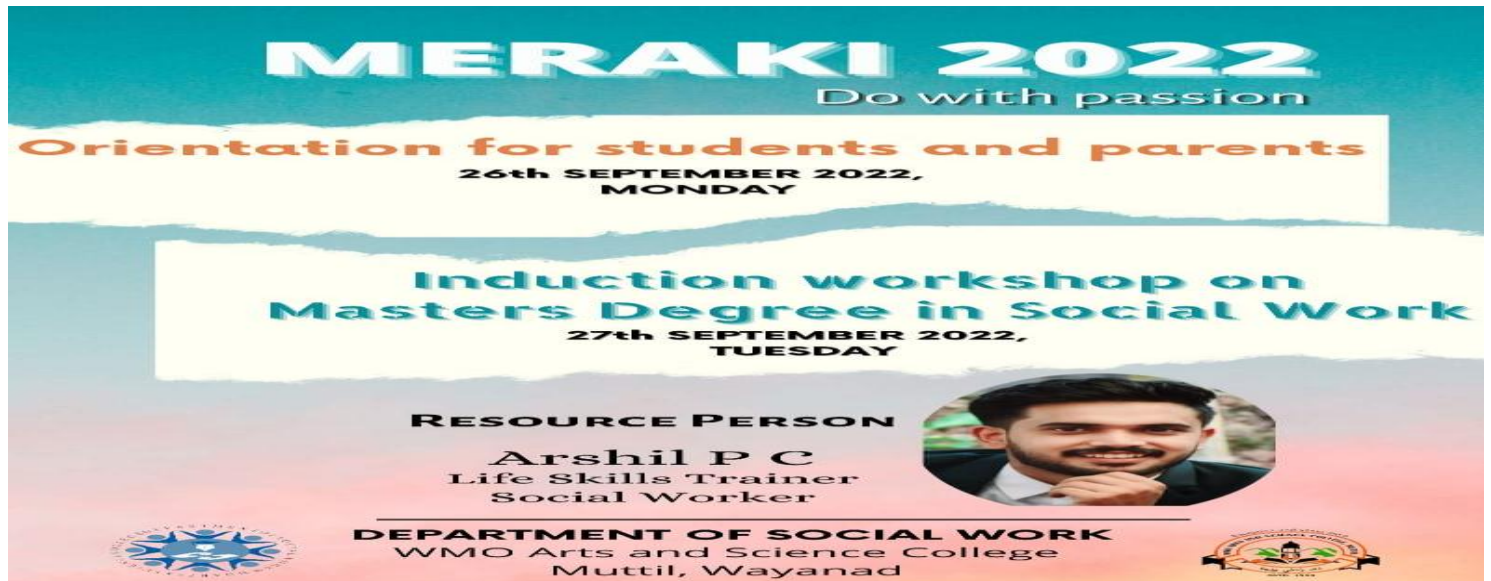

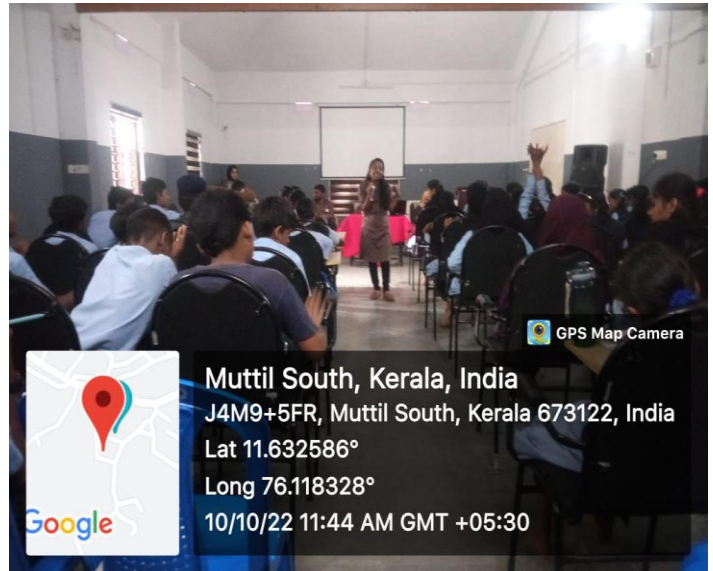
## FIKA- 22

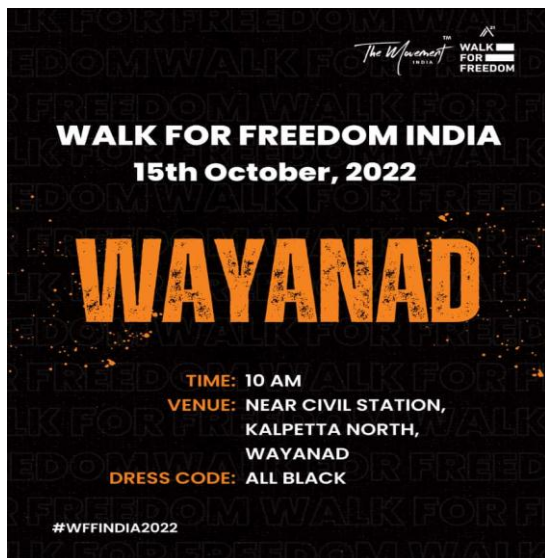






## WALK FOR FREEDOM

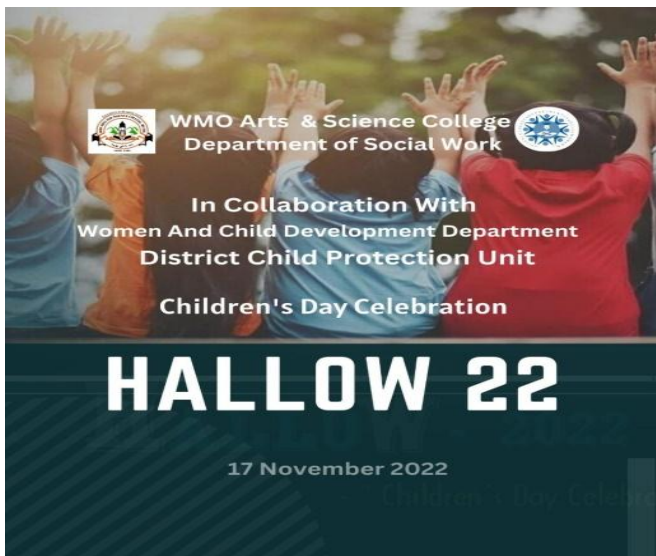






## HALLOW 2022 (Child protection week)

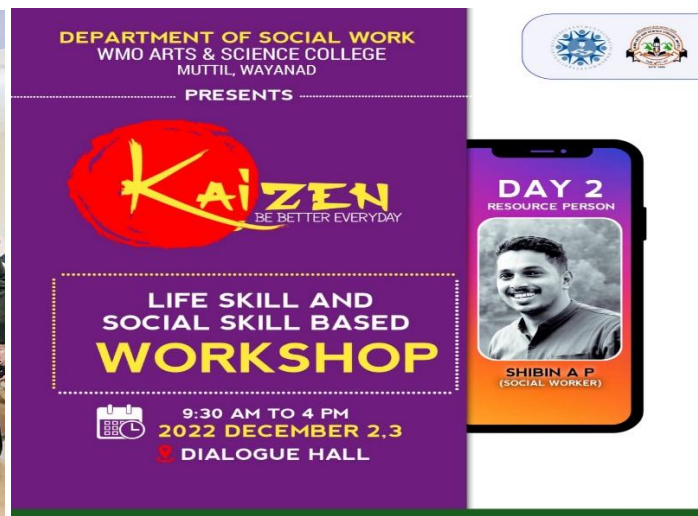
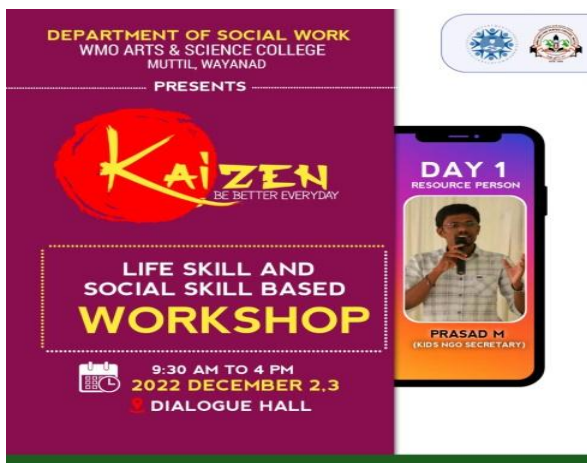






## KAIZEN

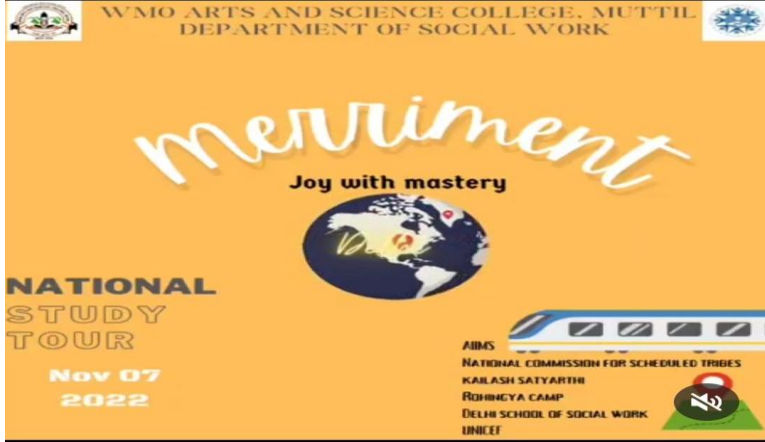

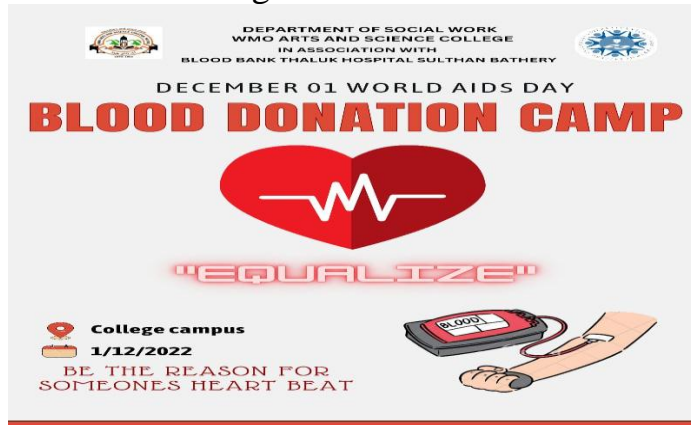




## AIDS DAY

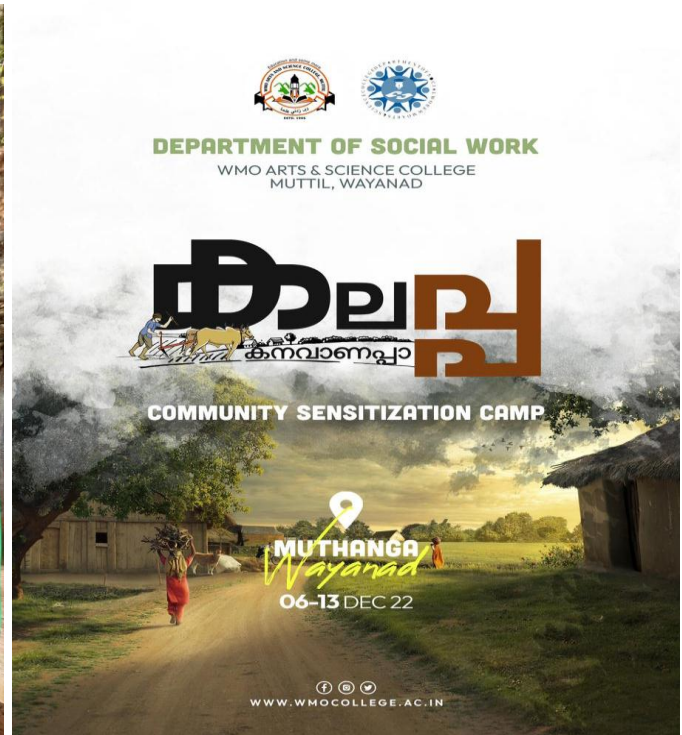
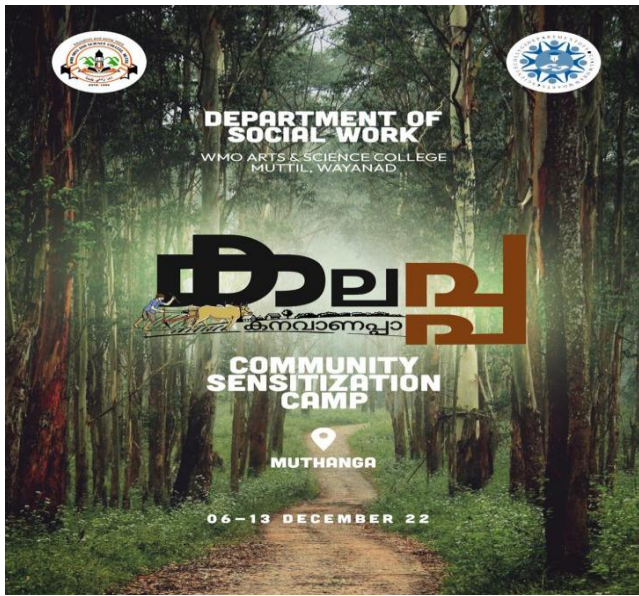

Department of social work conducted a field work community programs for people in various panchayats of Wayanad District. The target community of the programmes were people who were marginalised from mainstream

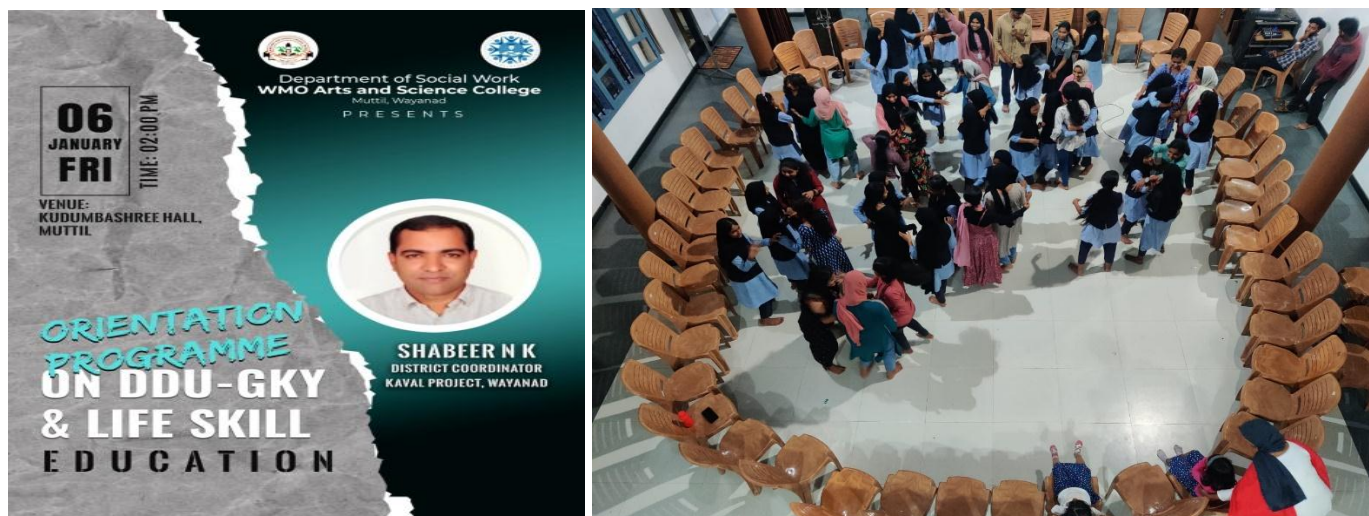

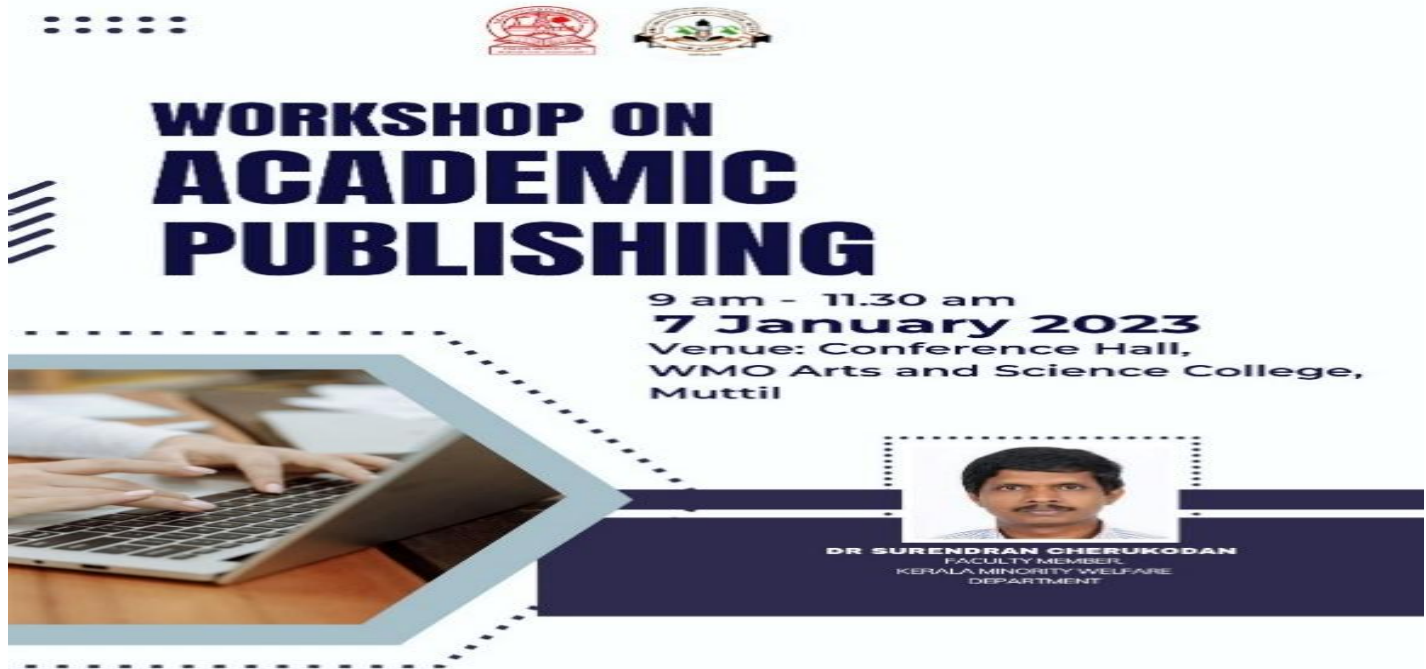




## ACADEMIC PUBLISHING: 'Resources and Platform'

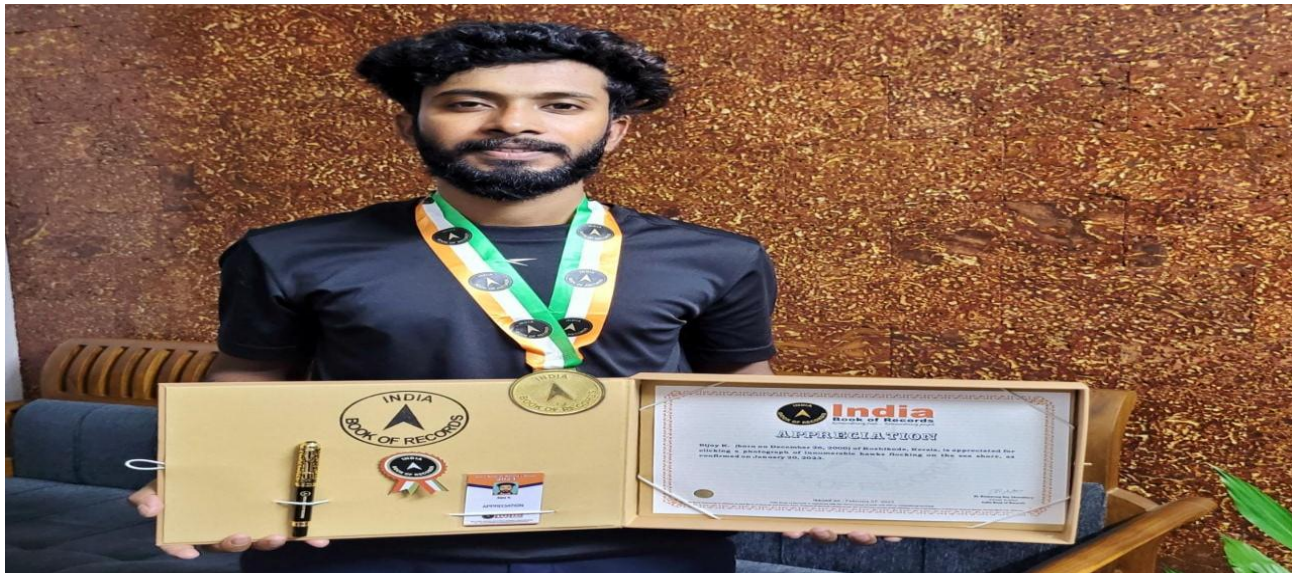
## Achievements of Faculty
