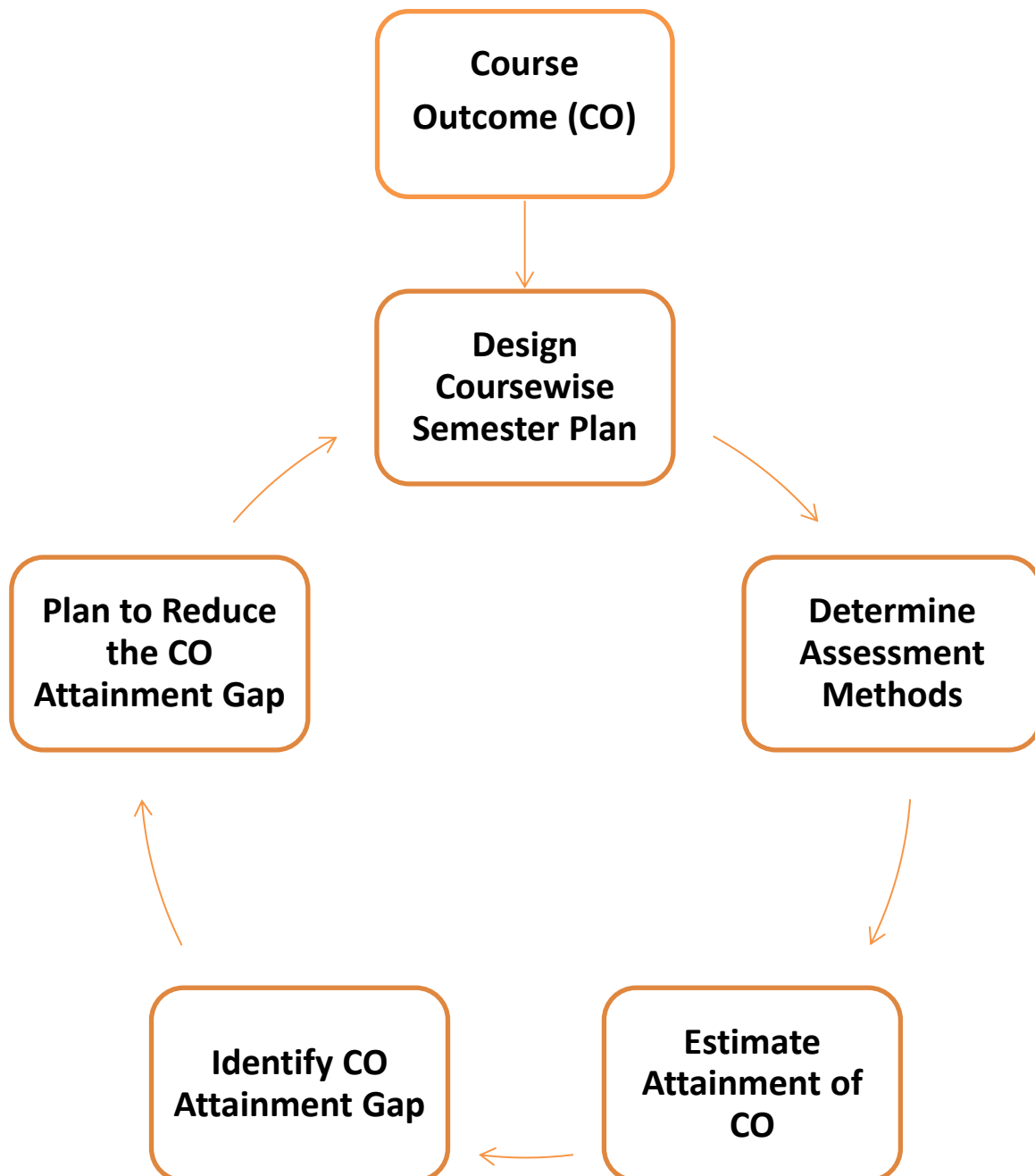

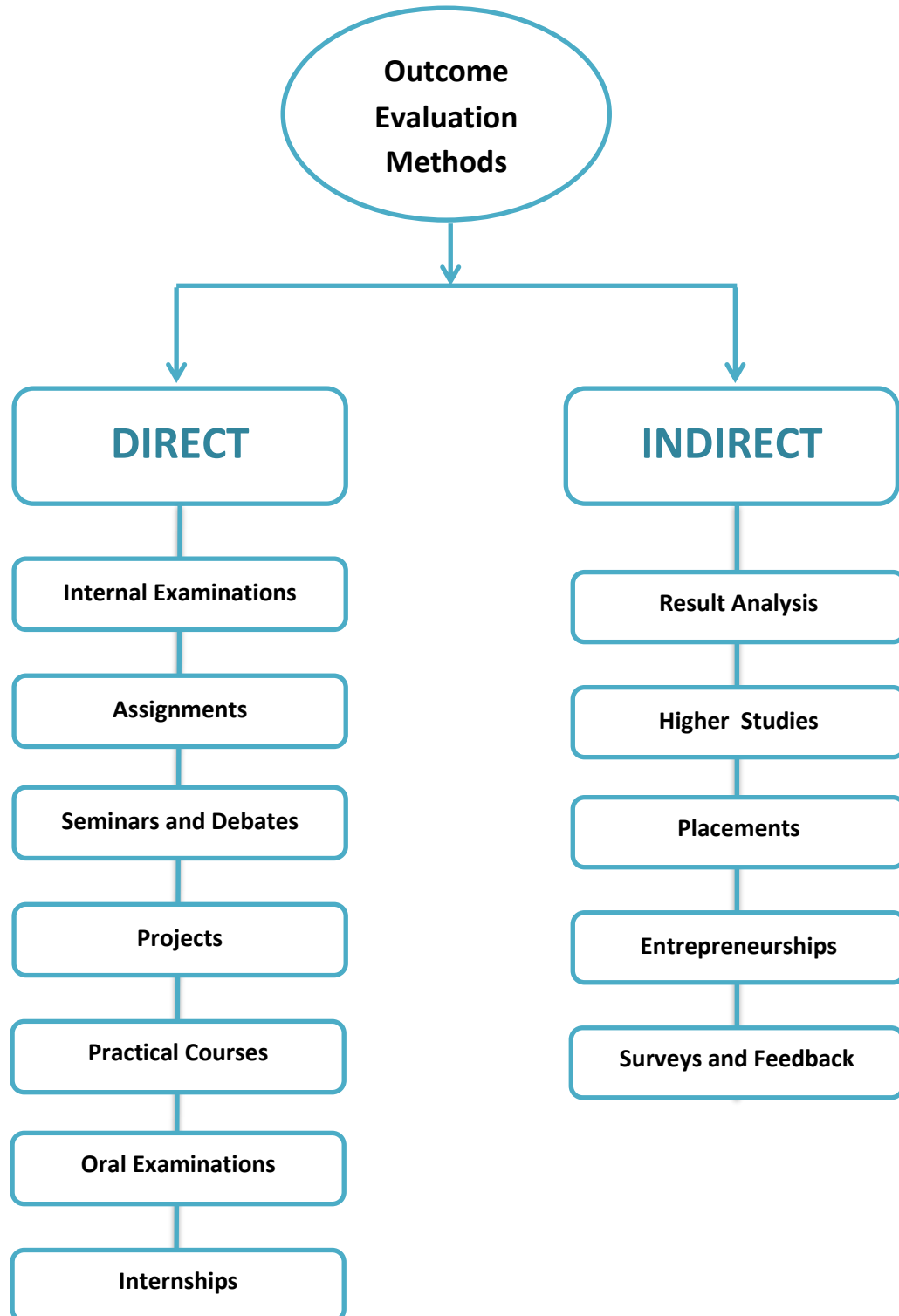

## **DIRECT ASSESSMENT METHODS**

## Internal Examinations

- Internal examinations are conducted at the end of each unit to evaluate the attainment of competency demanded by the course in that unit.
- The questions are designed to assess the attainment of the COs and PSOs defined.

## Assignments

- Assignments are given to students to complete independently or in groups.
- They are used to identify the level of students' understanding of course concepts, their ability to apply knowledge and skill.
- Assignments are designed in align with specific course outcomes, allowing teachers to measure students' progress in achieving those outcomes.

## Seminars

- Students present and discuss specific topics related to the course.
- It encourages critical thinking, oral communication skills, and the ability to engage in scholarly discussions.

## Projects

- Students get opportunity to apply the knowledge, skills, and concepts learned in the course to solve real-world problems or complete comprehensive tasks.
- Projects are selected in align with specific course outcomes and serve as a measure of student attainment



## Practical Courses

- Practical courses focus on developing specific skills and competencies. Assessments can be designed to evaluate students' proficiency in these skills, directly aligning with course outcomes.
- Teacher assesses the students' ability to apply their learning in real-world contexts, problem-solving skills, critical thinking abilities, and the application of theoretical knowledge to practical situations.

## Oral Examinations

- The questions in the oral examinations are designed to measure specific course outcomes, focusing on the depth of knowledge, comprehension, and application of the subject matter.



## Internships

- Internships can be used to assess students' ability to apply their knowledge, develop professional skills, and achieve the desired outcomes in real-world settings.

## **INDIRECT ASSESSMENT METHODS**

## Result Analysis

- At the beginning of each academic year, the departments analyse the university results of their passed out students in the departmental meeting.
- HoDs of the departments present the result analysis and remedial measures taken (if any) in the staff meeting.
- Pass percentage of a programme gives a glimpse to the rate of attainment of the programme outcomes.

## Students' Enrolment in Higher Studies

- Departments collect the data of students who opted higher studies after graduation
