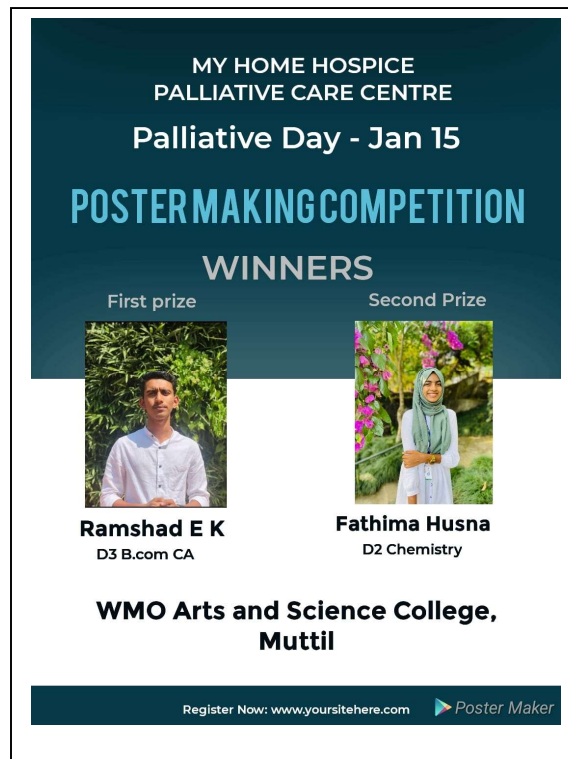
REPORT ON PREMARITAL COUNSELLING
