2. In case of a natural disaster, if temporary rehabilitation is required, the available infrastructural facilities of WMOC and all voluntary services of the student volunteers will be provided to Muttal GP.
3. To provide voluntary service in socio- economic survey conducted by Muttal GP for the annual as well as five year plan preparations.
4. To engage in any survey to find out landless and homeless families within the jurisdiction of Muttal GP in connection with any of its project implementation or plan proposals.
5. The students of WMOC residing in the administrative area of Muttal GP will voluntarily participate in the Grama sabha convened for the plan formulations and thereby try to strengthen the people's campaign programme. The participation in the Grama sabha will be recognized as an integral part of Calicut University Social Service Program (CUSSP).
6. To take up educational extension activities in the jurisdiction of Muttal GP so that not even a single student within the age group of 6 – 15 shall not be a drop out.
7. To create awareness among the society on environmental issues like plastic disposal, waste management, and tree plantation to the neighbourhood community of WMOC.
8. To promote and encourage Rainwater harvesting for the sustainability of the ground water table of Muttal GP, where WMOC undertakes environmental as well as educational projects/activities.
9. To create awareness on the impact of the excess application of pesticides/chemical fertilizers and to promote good agricultural practices in the agricultural lands of Muttal GP
10. To undertake, promote and support the efforts of Muttal GP to achieve sustainable development in agricultural and social sectors through the transparent and timely annual plan implementation.


