
Sweep Wayanad Campus to Campus


Panel Discussion


Webinar on Global Relevance of Arabic Language



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
Webinar on 'Kerala PSC Research Officer and Statistical Investigator -Prospects and Challenges'


Awareness Program

Bridge Course

1. SOCIAL WORK

A bridge course in social work serves as a pivotal pathway for individuals seeking to embark on a rewarding and impactful career in the field. Designed to provide a comprehensive foundation, this specialized program bridges the gap between diverse educational backgrounds and the requirements of a social work degree. By offering a unique blend of theoretical knowledge and practical skills, the bridge course equips students with the necessary tools to navigate the complexities of social issues and contribute effectively to the betterment of individuals, families, and communities. This introduction explores the significance of bridge courses in social work, highlighting their role in preparing aspiring professionals for the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead.

2. MASS COMMUNICATION AND JOURNALISM

The Department of Mass communication& Journalism, WMO college of Arts and Sciences, Muttil, offers a Bridge course for the students of first year B.A Mass communication. It is a 5 day-long course taking 4 hours each day. Scheduled in to three different modules, it is been offered as a regular program since its introduction in the academic year 2018. The course primarily helps a students to unlearn and relearn her student life or student-ship. The teacher/trainer acts as a facilitator cum mentor helping the students to get familiar with the course, the new educational atmosphere she lands in to, and the quite unfamiliar pedagogy adopted by the higher education sector in the country. Along with other timely accompaniments, the course is largely conceived of three basic modules. These three need-based-modules facilitate a student in terms of her self-learning and introduce her to the culture of 'the scholarship' and 'higher education'. Thus, Bridge course proves to be the best opportunity for a student to adapt herself to the academic and social environment, which many often is new for her.
