
CERTIFICATE COURSE, VALUE ADDED & BRIDGE COURSE 2020-21

The certificate course on video editing is a short-term training program designed to provide students with the skills and knowledge required to edit and manipulate video footage. The Course covers the basic principles of video editing, including concepts such as color correction, sound design, and visual effects. The curriculum typically includes both theoretical and practical components, with students learning the key concepts and principles of video editing through classroom lectures and hands-on training. They may work with a variety of video editing software tools, such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro, etc. 33 students successfully completed the course. Bridge courses are conducted every year to familiarize our first year students on the basics of communication studies.

In 2020 -2021 academic year, 10 students are enrolled with value added course offered the department. Classes are taken in online platforms including Zoom and Google Meet. The first day of the class commenced on 2021 April 19 and ends on 2021 April 30.
