Aims and Objectives

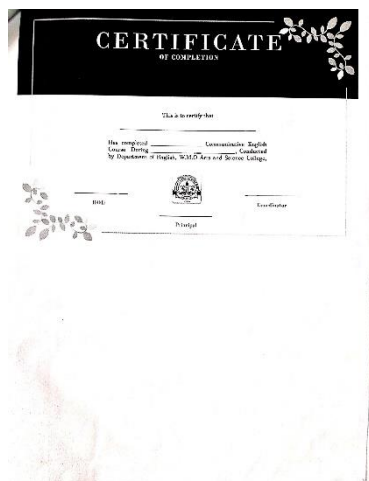
- > To develop students' sense of understanding, appreciation and ability of expression

Second BA students of the department conducted students seminars on various topics from English Literature. Ameera Diya, Neha Nourin , Adhul Girish, were presented papers .

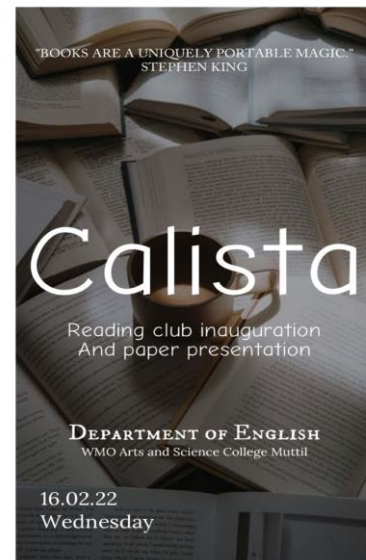

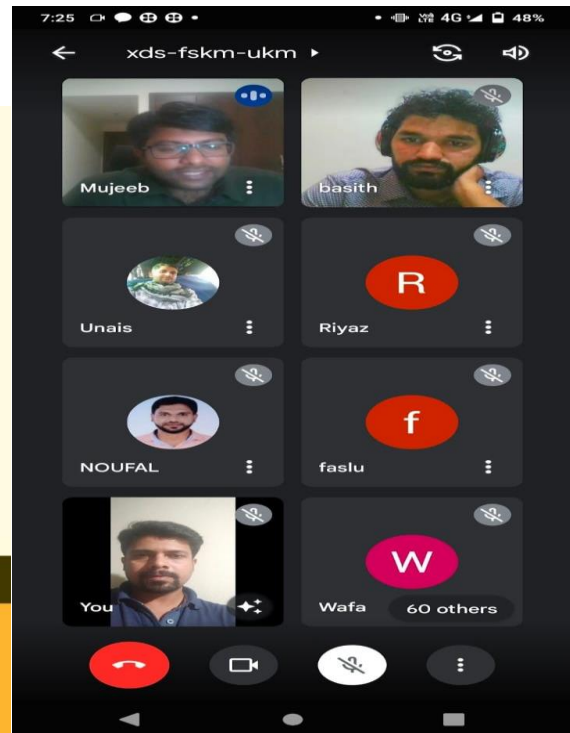


Webinar

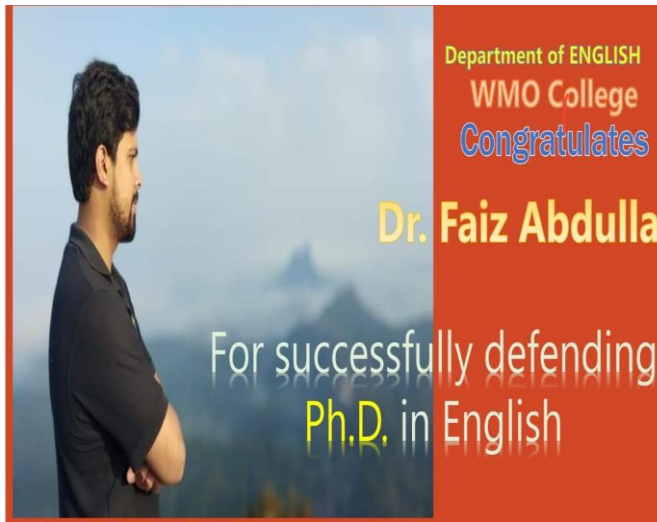
