1. INDUSTRIAL VISIT

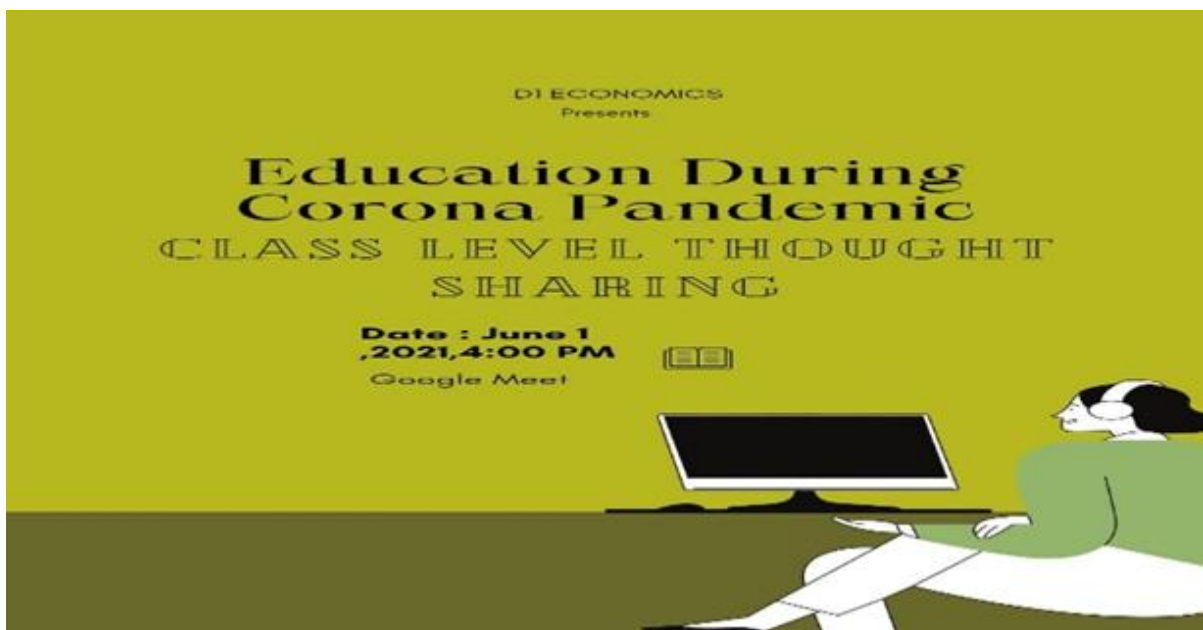
