

#### 4. MAGAZINE RELEASE & HONURING VOLUNTEERS






### 6. INVITED TALK& ASSOCIATION INAUGRATION








#### 8. COMMEMORATION

### **Gender Equity & Student Well-being:**


- Our Gender Equity Scheme includes the "Emergency Medical Relief for Girls (EMERG)" scheme, ensuring critical support for female students during medical emergencies

- The department also organizes commemoration events like Environment Day, tributes to influential figures such as Dr. Manmohan Singh, and photography contest


#### **CERTIFICATE COURSES**
