II. Library collection statistics.

Books Collection: At the beginning of the academic year 2020-21 the library had 16272 books. During the academic year, 268 new books were added to the collection, bringing the total number of books to 16540. The library has a wide range of books on different subjects, including textbooks, reference books, and popular reading material.

Journals Collection: The library subscribes to 46 print journals in various subjects. In addition, it has access to a vast collection of e-journals through online databases. This provides users with access to the latest research articles and other scholarly publications.

E-Resources Collection: The library has a large collection of e-books, with over 3,135,000 titles available through various online databases. In addition, it provides

access to over 6,237 e-journals, making it a valuable resource for research scholars and students.
