# **DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK**

#### INTRODUCTION

Department of social work was established in the year of 2014. This is a self financing course affiliated under university of Calicut. MSW is the only professional course in the college. There are four semesters in the course which include Theories, Field work (Concurrent and Block placement) for each semesters and Dissertation in final semester. The department in the college is offering two specializations these are Medical and Psychiatric Social Work and Rural and Urban Community Development. The course include 28 papers, five sessions of field works (Concurrent and Block placement), 18 field visits (national and local), one community living camp and a mini research.

Two batches are out till now with 100% result. Department of social work had conducted many academic programs, activities, camps with the academic year 2017-18.

## I. Camps

Department of social work conducted two camps in 2017-18 academic years

- a) Neermathalam
- b) Tribal community camp

#### **Neermathalam- penkuttam**

Department had conducted Four Days residential camp for degree female students at college from 17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> April 2017. The camp aimed at enhancing the personality aspects and life skills of the students. Students of 8 different institutions from Wayanad, Calicut and Malappuram districts participated in the camp. Different sessions on personality development, career development, and women empowerment were dealt by different faculties.

#### Tribal community living camp

Department of social work conducted 10 days residential tribal camp for the students of first semester MSW at Kajagadi and Madhyapadi forest settlement colonies of

Thirunelly Panchayath, from 12<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2017. The camp aimed at enabling social living of the students along with experiencing rural community life, need assessment survey, knowing the culture and evolution of the tribal community. Problem identification, project formulation & collective charity was some of the activities conducted in the camp. As the follow up of the camp, three projects are ongoing, including a documentary preparation, academic research work, and project implementation of the tribal classes for the students at Aranappara.

#### Workshops

Department of social work conducted workshops for the students they include, Transactional Analysis, Participatory Rural Approach, Basics of Counseling, SPSS and Project. Experts of respective fields handed the workshop.

#### Seminars

Faculty and students of the department attended various National and International seminars during the academic period of 2017-18

Miss Noorjahan K attended two workshops, international colloquium of higher education, conducted by department of English, SS College Areacode and International Conference on Time Effective Brief Therapies, conducted by IMHANS Calicut. She presented a paper at international colloquium on Tribal Education: An Ethnographic Exploration to the Education Life of Tribal children in Wayanad District.

Four of the faculties from the Department attended curriculum orientation program conducted at Vimala College.

Two students participated at Academic Seminar on Social Work Opportunities in Various Fields conducted by Department of Social Work, Vimala College.

Six students specialized in Rural and Urban Community Development participated at national seminar on "Critical Perspective on Community Organization and Collective Actions: Beyond the Bounds of Methods"

Department of Social Work undertook a Community Development project on a nearby Tribal community. The project aims at educational empowerment by controlling dropout, enhancement of the life skills of the children and youth and guidance.

Two of the first year students are currently working in the colony as part of their field work.
