In this very time span the other groups did their jobs of food packing at SKMJ and dress sorting at Panamaram. After this volunteers were assigned a bigger goal of cleaning the flood area of Mundery colony. The condition of the colony was very pathetic and grim. Cleaning process was a big task, but we work together with full of sincerity. There was water logging and floating debris. The primary focus was to clean the houses and surrounded areas. We made sure the place was clean and hygiene. There, the colony members were also helpful.

Then we were part of a survey to help govt. to understand the situation of Wayanad after flood. The survey was initiated to get the clear cut picture of the destructive situation and to know the needs of people. This survey had two units; one at Panamaram and other at Pozhuthana. Everyone was inaction to fulfil their assigned responsibility. Lastly we did mission clean Wayanad in co-operation with district administration.
