The content / curriculum

Must be designed separately for each year as independent bucket (A/B/C). It must remain flexible based on the valuable inputs and suitably customize the curriculum so that the participants will fit in to the industrial scenario meaningfully.

Placement

Uniware Academy not responsible for any job assurance, however academy will provide all possible assistance for the students to empower themselves.

Training Schedule

The online training schedule can be proposed by WMO with the Mutual consent by Uniware Training Academy for the implementation.

Assessment

There will be assessments after each module.

Payment clause

The training fee of Rs 500 Per student per year and to be disbursed before the commencement of training respective year, based on the number of students enrolled.

Force majore

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Report of Memorandum of Understanding between Placement Cell of WMO College

&

Uniware Training Academy

2020-21

The Placement Cell of our college played a vital role in preparing and assisting the students with their career goals during the academic year 2020-21. The following points highlight the various activities and achievements of the Placement Cell during the period.

- 1. MOU Signed with Uniware Academy: The Placement Cell signed an MOU with Uniware Academy on 20-11-2020 to conduct employability training programmes for students.
- 2. Orientation Programme for III Semester UG Students: On 23-11-2020, an orientation programme was conducted for third-semester undergraduate students, and 180 students attended the programme. Vidhya Conceio and Renesh Ravi were the resource persons for the programme.
- 3. Training Programmes for Students: On 06-01-2021, training programmes were conducted for students, and more than 100 students registered and participated in different sessions.
- 4. Placement Orientation for Final Year UG Students: Placement orientation was conducted for final year undergraduate students on 27-01-2021 and 28-01-2021 to prepare them for the recruitment process.
- 5. Orientation Programme for Faculty Members: On 29-01-2021, an orientation programme was conducted for faculty members to update them on the latest trends in the industry and the recruitment process.
- 6. Orientation Programme for Second-Year Arts and Humanities Batch: An orientation programme was conducted for the second-year arts and humanities batch on 15-



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04-2021 to educate them about the recruitment process and the skills required for employment.

- 7. Shortlisted Students: 13 undergraduate students were shortlisted for WIPRO, and 8 were shortlisted for other companies. Additionally, 28 postgraduate students were shortlisted for other companies.
- 8. Training Programme for Students: One hundred ten students registered for the 40-hour training session, which aimed to boost their self-confidence, communication skills, personality development, self-assessment, skill development for different types of interviews, mock interviews, personal assessment, and assistance till employment, etc. The training sessions were completed by 31st May 2021. A nominal fee of Rs.500 per student is collected for these sessions.
- 9. Limitations during COVID-19: The Placement Cell faced several limitations in conducting classes during the COVID-19 pandemic. However, they organized many online sessions for the students to help them prepare for the recruitment process.
