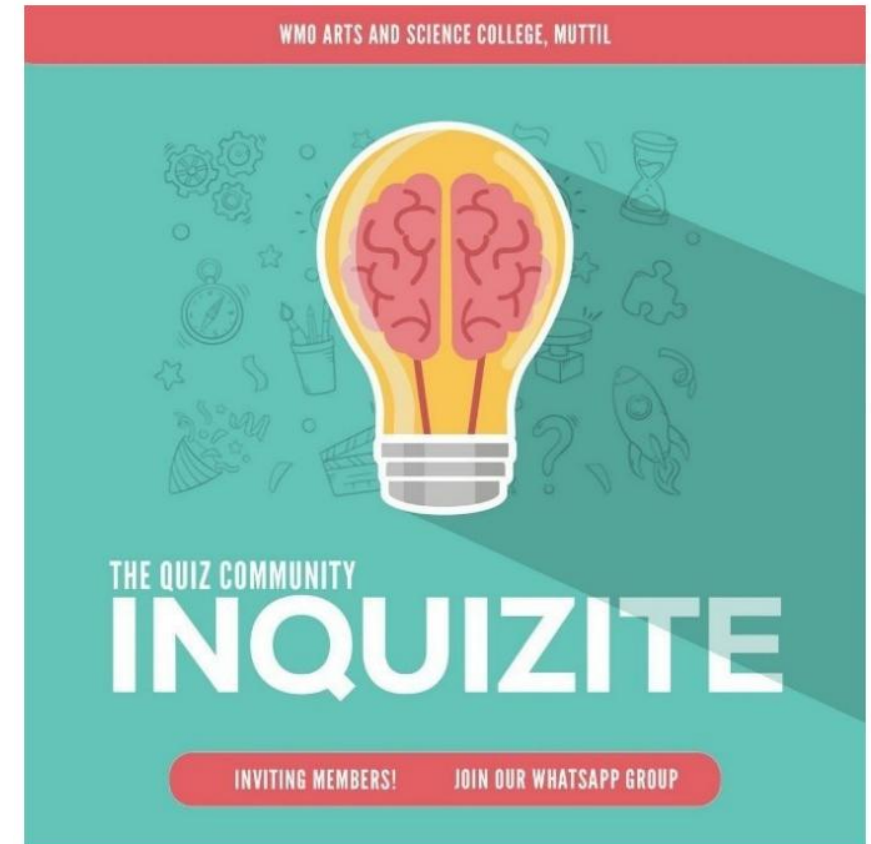


Inquizite – Quiz Club Activity Report 2024–2025

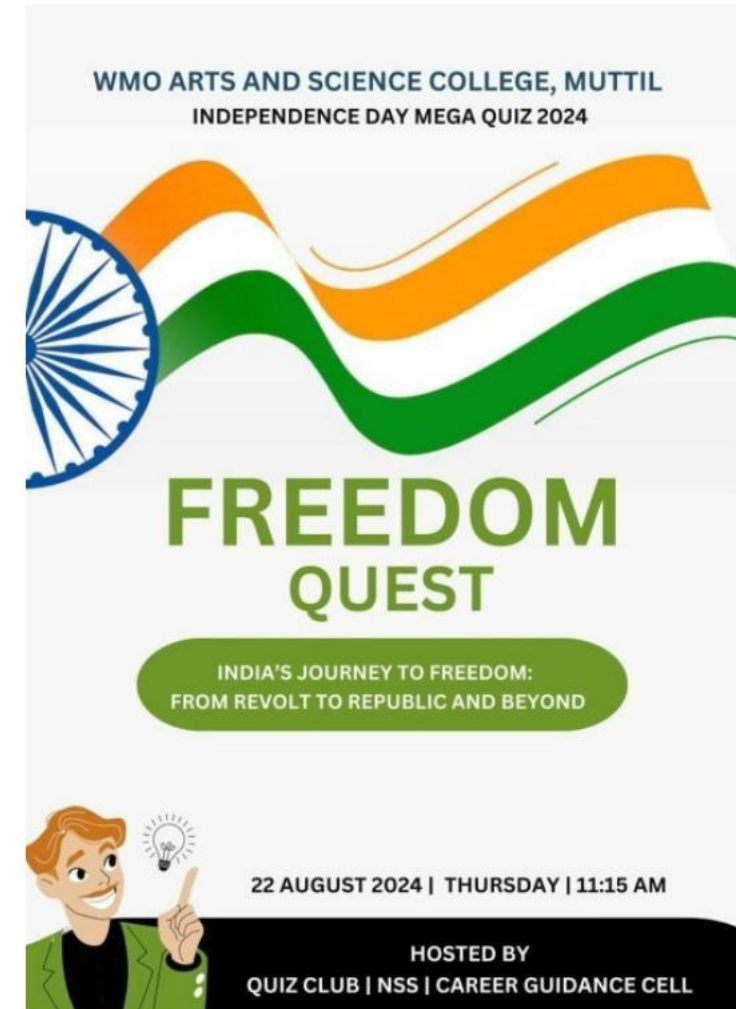
About Inquizite

- Top 50 students advanced to the next round.



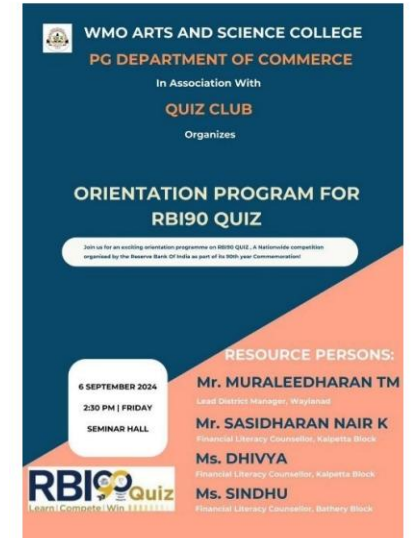
2. Independence Day Mega Quiz – Final Round

- Included session by Financial Literacy Counsellors and quiz overview.



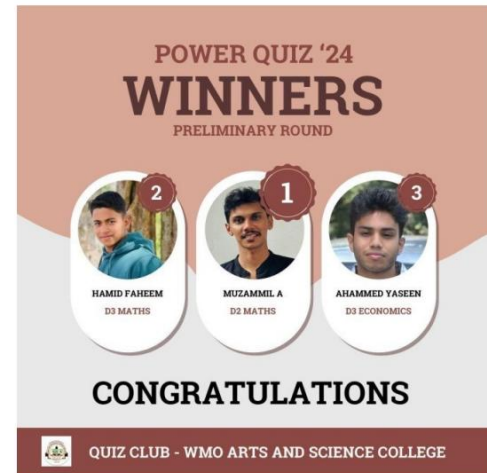
4. Career Interactive Seminar

- Discussed Civil Services prep strategies and celebrated quiz winners.



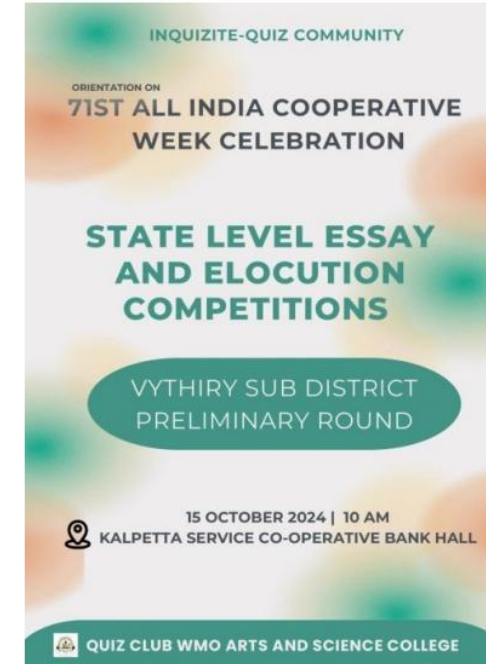
5. Power Quiz – Preliminary Round

- Keynote: Dr. Thomas J Thevara; practical strategies and motivation shared.



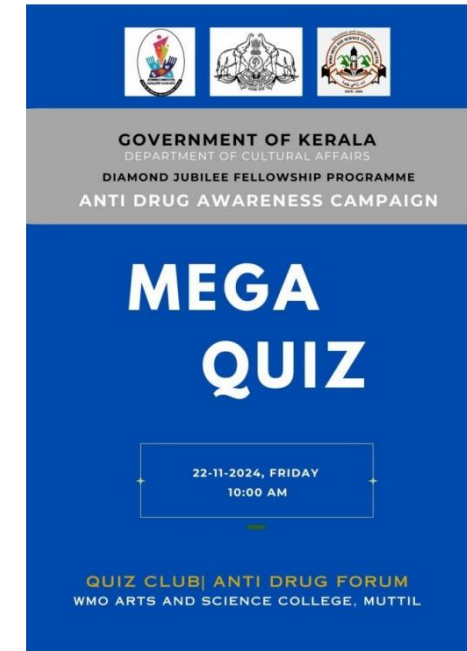
8. The Poll Quest – Election Literacy Quiz

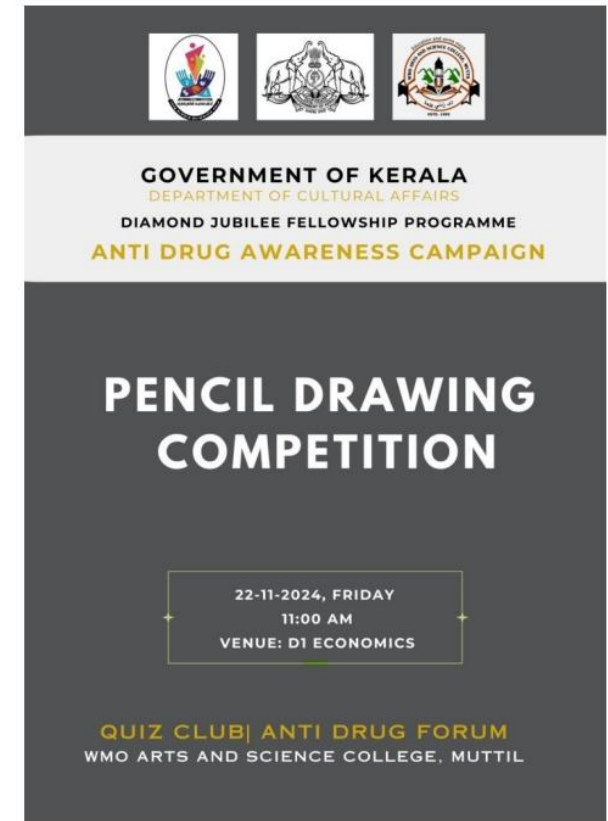
9. Anti-Drug Awareness – Mega Quiz

- Integrated educational and social awareness on drug abuse.



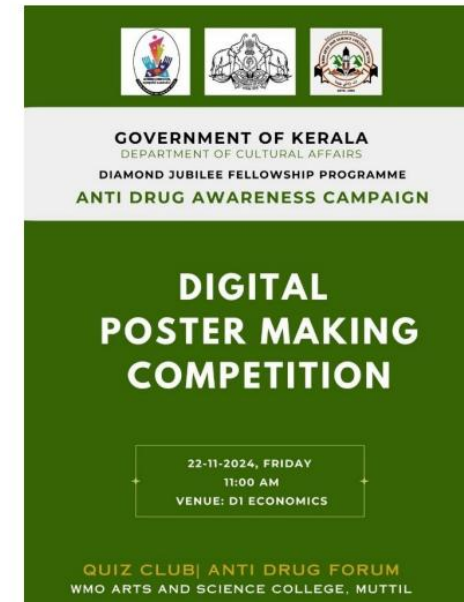
10. Pencil Drawing Competition – Resilience

- Showcased students' creativity and message-driven art.



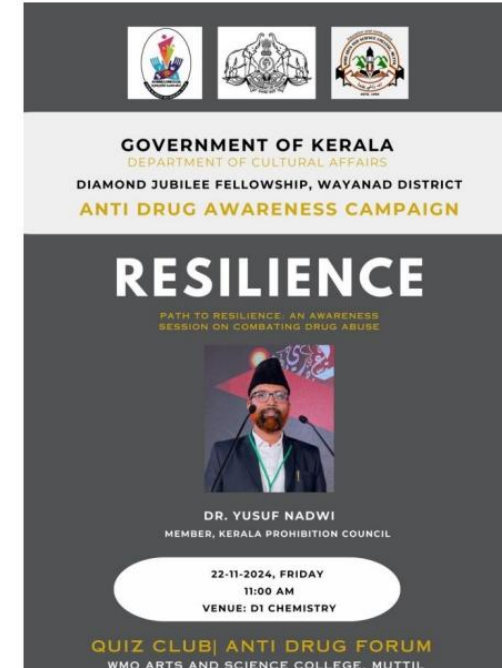
11. Digital Poster Making Competition

- Engaged and impacted audience through creativity



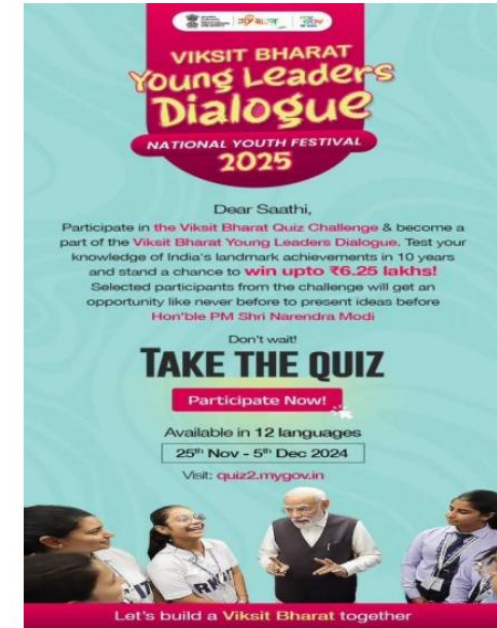
14. Lights of Samvidhan – Constitution Day Quiz
