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## Scholar Support Programme (SSP)

The Scholar Support Programme (SSP) aims at extending personalized additional support to students in the subjects included in the curriculum through Tutorials, study materials, additional lectures, question banks and interactive sessions. Colleges included in the Programme will identify at college level, the subjects in which students need additional support. This can be based on the Result Analysis conducted at the University level or as per the local requirements of the students of the College. In addition to special classes by faculty, study material will be provided to the students selected to the Programme. Content generation through setting up of Question Banks and videos are also components of the Programme. The candidates from the first semester of the Under Graduate Programme are selected for the Programme. A college should select a maximum of 5 subjects and a maximum of 50 students under the Programme. The selection of the subjects will be done at the college level. One of the subjects to be identified must be Common Course in English for which 10 students may be selected. The other subjects may be identified as per the needs of the college and students and based on 'Results Analysis work for the Scholar Support Programme. A coordinator identified from among the faculty would supervise the conduct of the Programme in the Colleges. The Programme will be offered for all semesters of the 3-year Under Graduate Programme.







Total 80 students of this College were part of this programme for the year 2019-20. Out of this, 40 students each from second year and first year were selected, and they were given intensive coaching in their weak areas by internal trainers, Language learning skills, Personal Growth, Subject Coaching for first Language by external/internal trainers

### **Internal Trainers**

Three monitoring committee meetings were arranged and the report and progress of the SSP were tabled. The dates for the completion of classes, submission of faculty documents were directed by the committee.






