



1. COLLOQUIUM-DATA FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND DECISION MAKING





Muhammad Shaifer P, Raseena K and Nihala P. There were ten participants. Among them the



Haneena and Aleena Kurian of statistics department, and 3rd prize for Riswana Jasmin and Fathima Febin of electronics department.


8. INDUSTRIAL VISIT-IIM CALICUT AND CWRDM CALICUT




