The following actions have been taken as per the analysis of the teachers' feedback by discussing with the authorities concerned:

1. A letter has been forwarded to the university and the university asked to obtain concurrence from the government of Kerala for changing the complementary course for BSc Physics Programme.
2. Many certificate courses were initiated with the approval of IQAC and the College Council
3. Decided to purchase more computers based on the proposal submitted by the Department of Computer Science.
4. Suggestions for modifications to the syllabus for certain programmes were pointed out to the members of the Board of Studies. A syllabus revision was made for BSc Mathematics Programme with effect from 2020 onwards.
5. Management started an initial plan for a spacious conference hall.
6. Decided to conduct a leisure trip by the end of the academic year.
7. Decided to organize a department-wise readers forum in association with the college library.
8. A suggestion to have a platform to ensure research and publications was pointed out and the matter was Intimated with the Publication Wing in the college.
9. The discipline committee organized orientation sessions on basic codes and conduct.
10. Special sessions were conducted for faculty to devise programme outcomes and course outcomes
