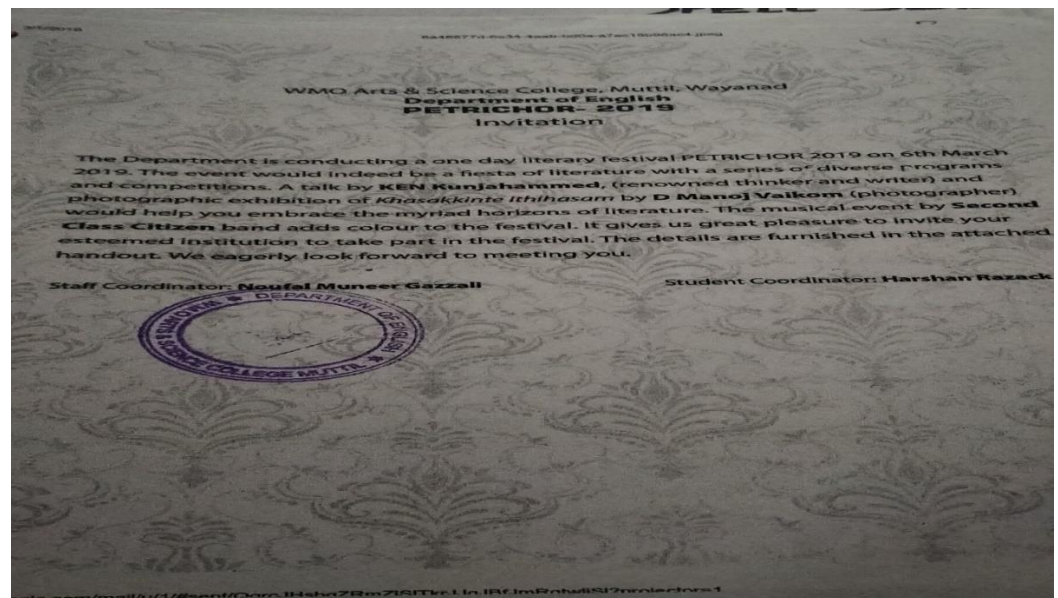


8. Workshop on Documentary Films
