II. Library collection statistics.

Books Collection: At the beginning of the academic year 2021-22 the library had 16540 books. During the academic year, 372 new books were added to the collection, bringing the total number of books to 16912. The library has a wide range of books on different subjects, including textbooks, reference books, and popular reading material.

Journals Collection: The library subscribes to 46 print journals in various subjects. In addition, it has access to a vast collection of e-journals through online databases. This provides users with access to the latest research articles and other scholarly publications.
