Actions Taken Report on Faculty Feedback

2021-22

The IQAC collected feedback from teachers during staff meetings. As a community that keeps in touch with the different syllabus revisions and the student standards from time to time, the most expert and resourceful suggestions were obtained from them. It is notable that teachers from most of the departments were satisfied with the density of the curriculum offered by the university. Specific suggestions from various departments were considered and necessary actions were taken.

The high difficulty level of some courses in the undergraduate syllabus implemented from 2019 onwards was pointed out and communicated the matter with Members of the Board of Studies. The University issued an order to give proper direction to exempt some portions and modify the syllabus for university examinations of the BSc Mathematics Programme in the academic year 2021-22. After the outbreak of Covid 19 Pandemic, many curricular and Co-curricular activities were conducted through online platforms as per the suggestions from faculty and students.

Dr. Biju KG, Associate Professor of Physics, WMO Arts and Science College, Muttil, as a member of the Board of Studies (BoS), effectively participated in modifying the curriculum according to the prevailing situations. The recommendations put forward by the Board of Studies were approved by the University.
